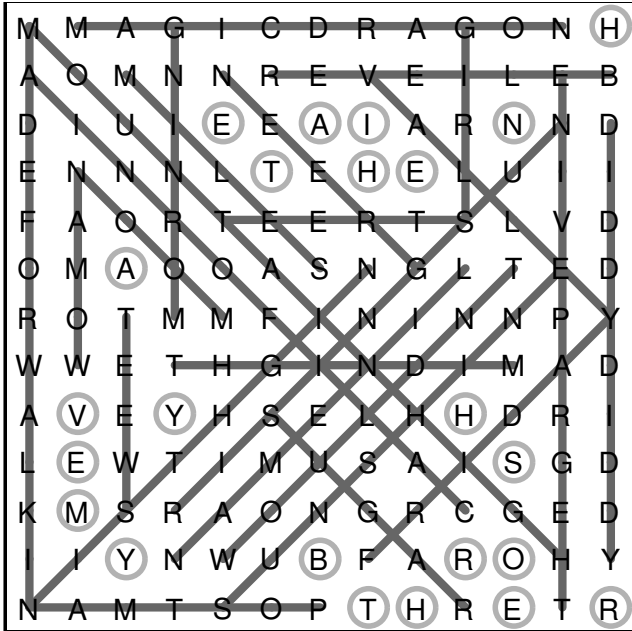


MATCH-UPS: CLASSIC 60s SONGS
