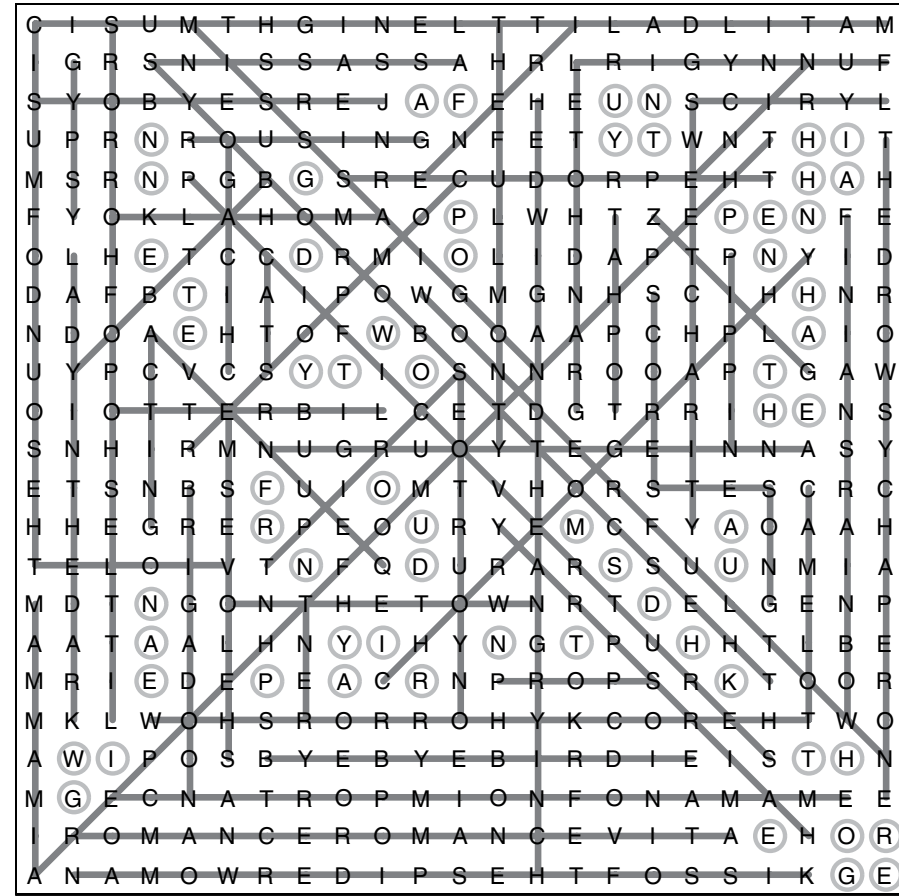


MONSTER FIND-A-WORD MUSICALS

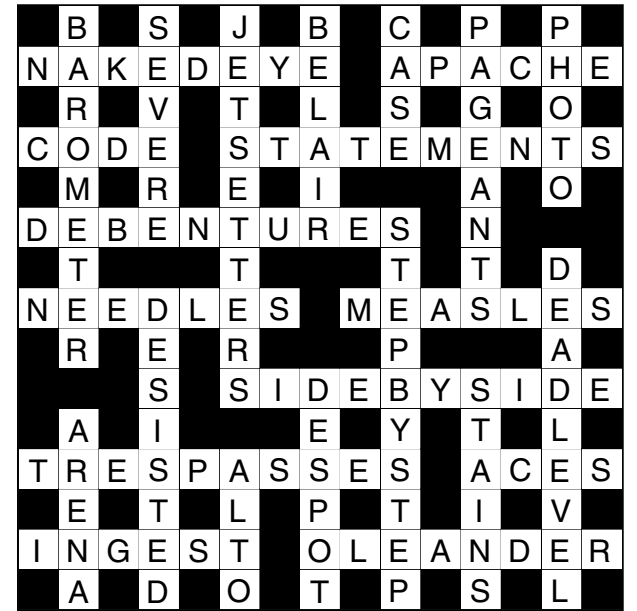

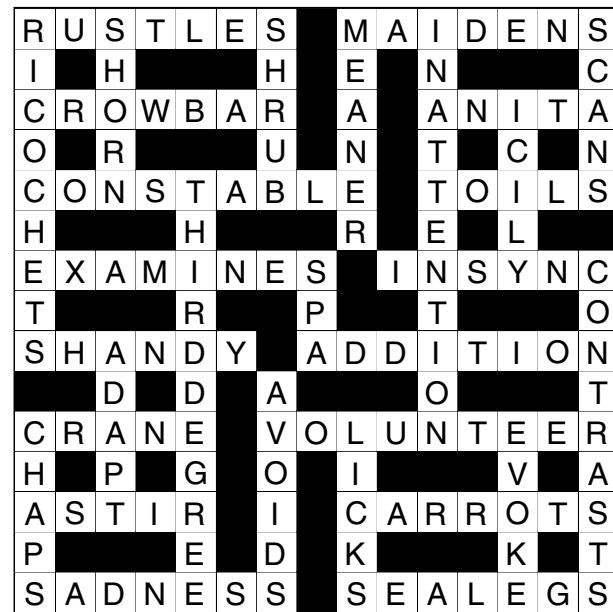

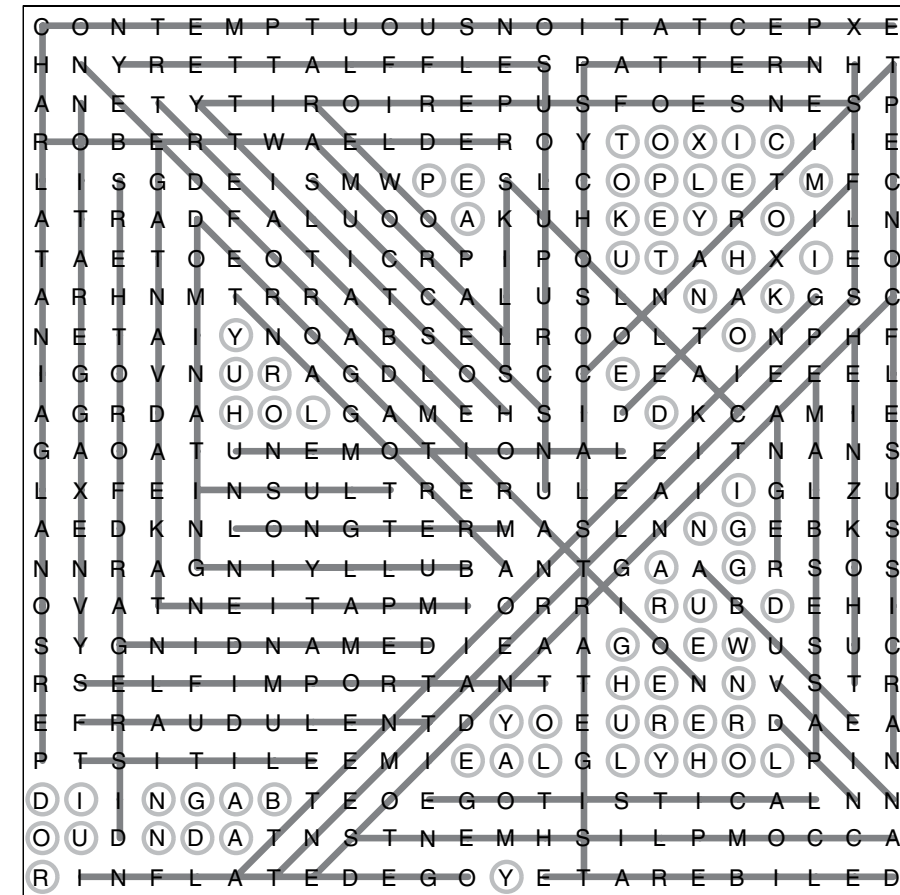
