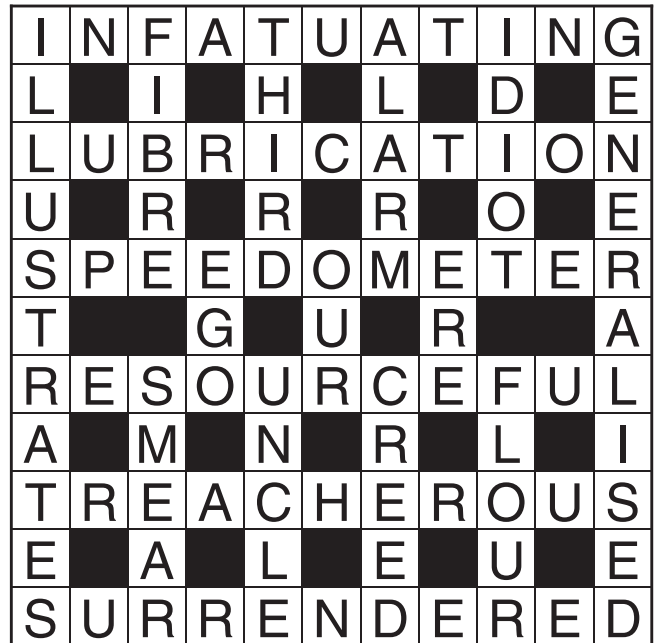
Going across, backwards, up, down and diagonally, complete the names. The leftover letters will reveal another literary character.

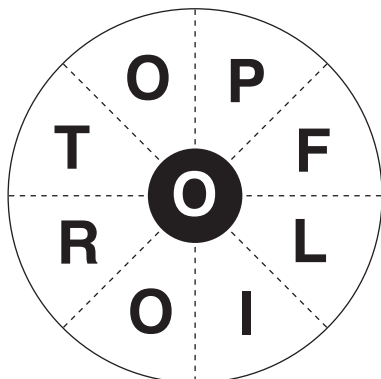
