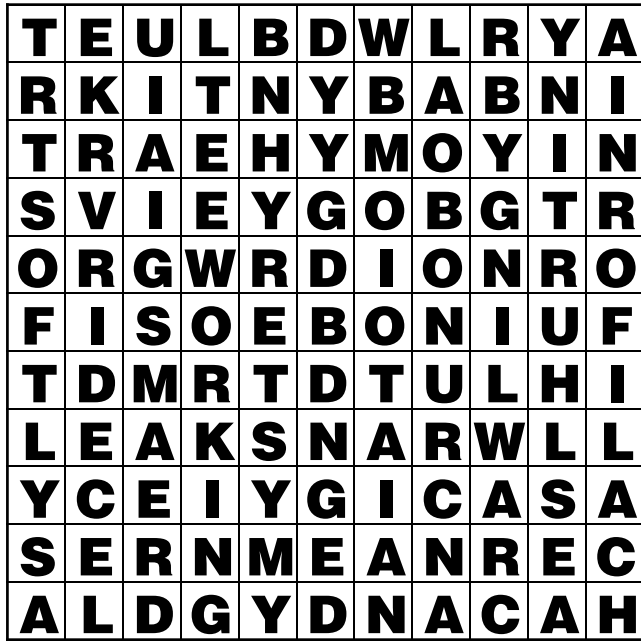


Match-Ups: Roy Orbison

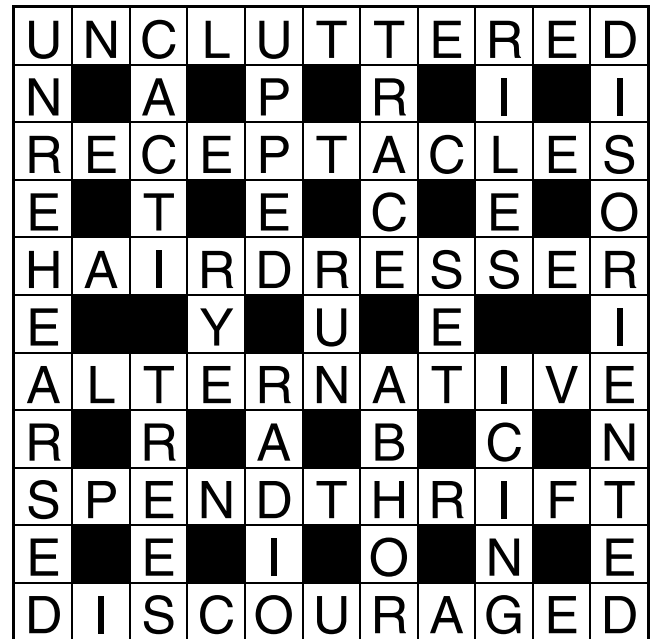

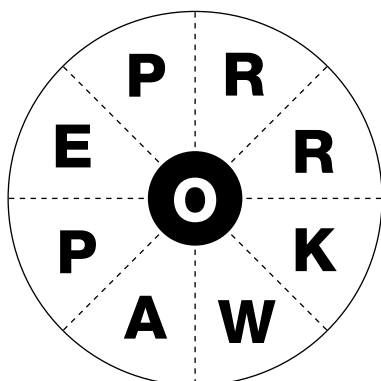
