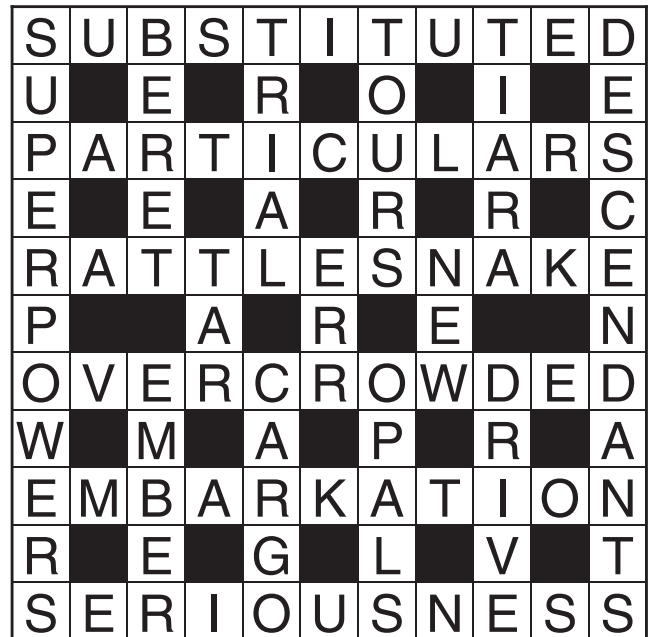
Across, backwards, up, down and diagonally, complete the titles of these dignitaries. The leftover letters will reveal a factor in dealing with them.

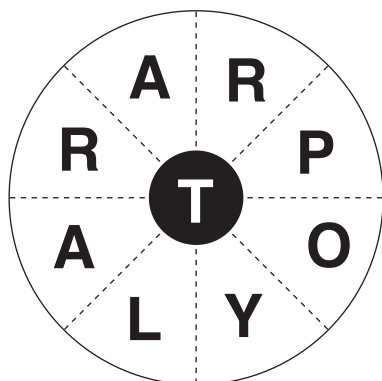
