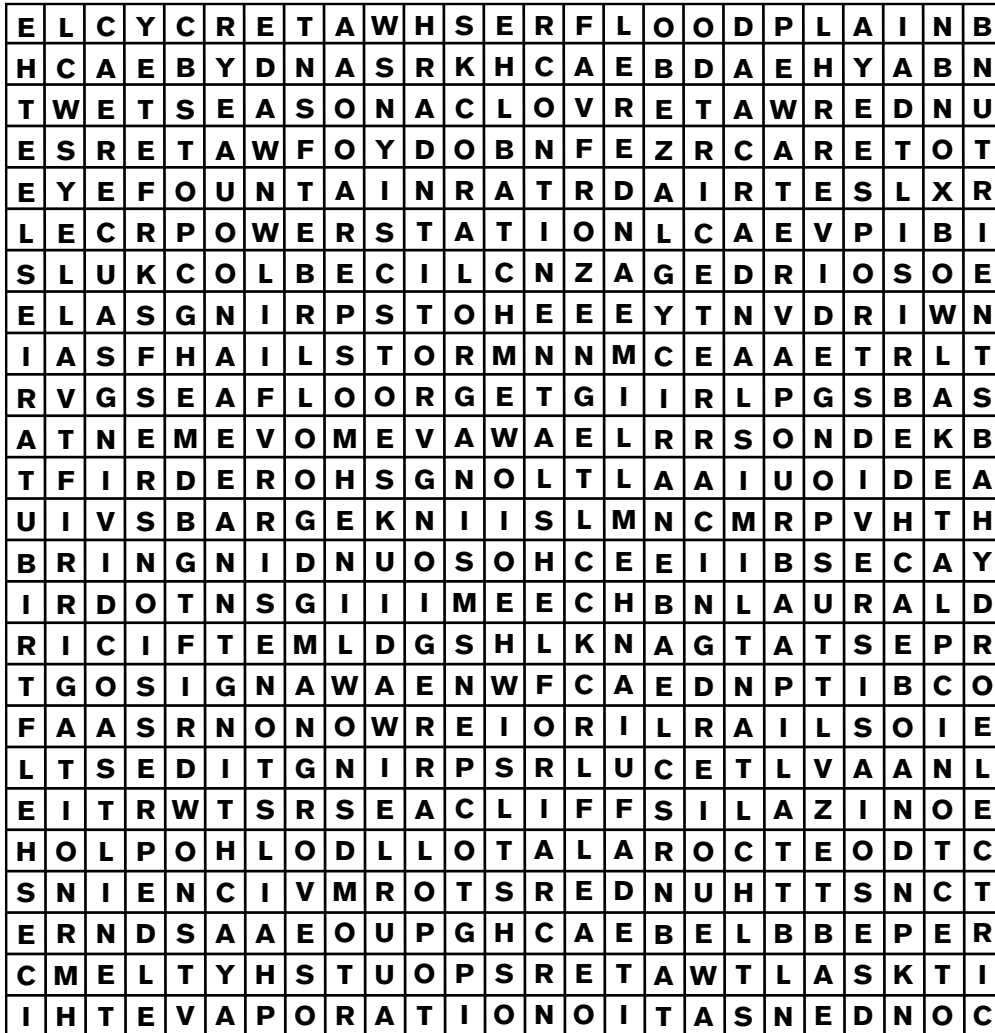


Water, Water, Everywhere!
