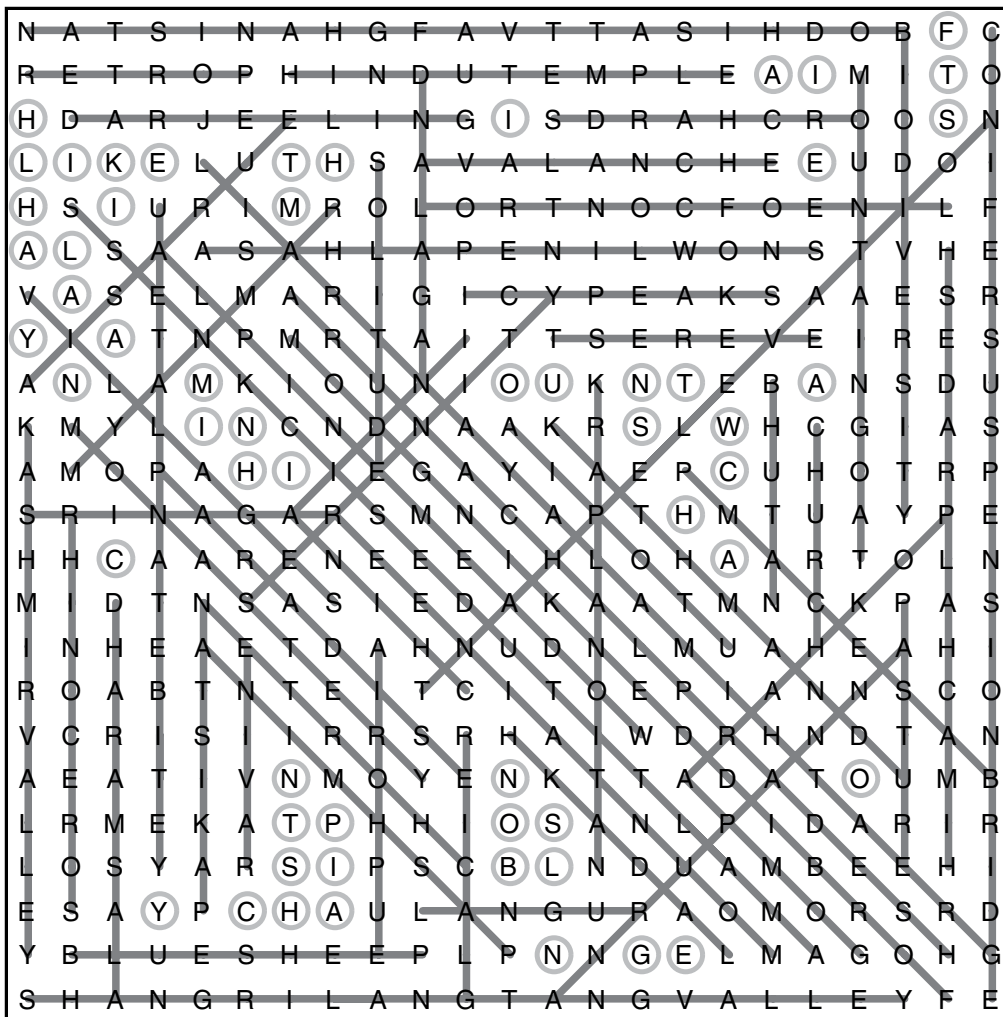


MONSTER FIND-A-WORD

ABODE OF SNOW

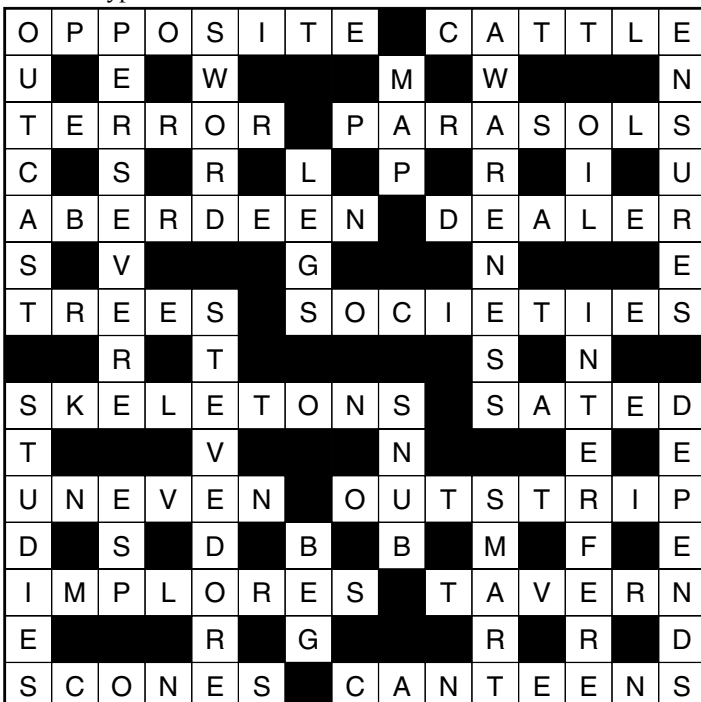
