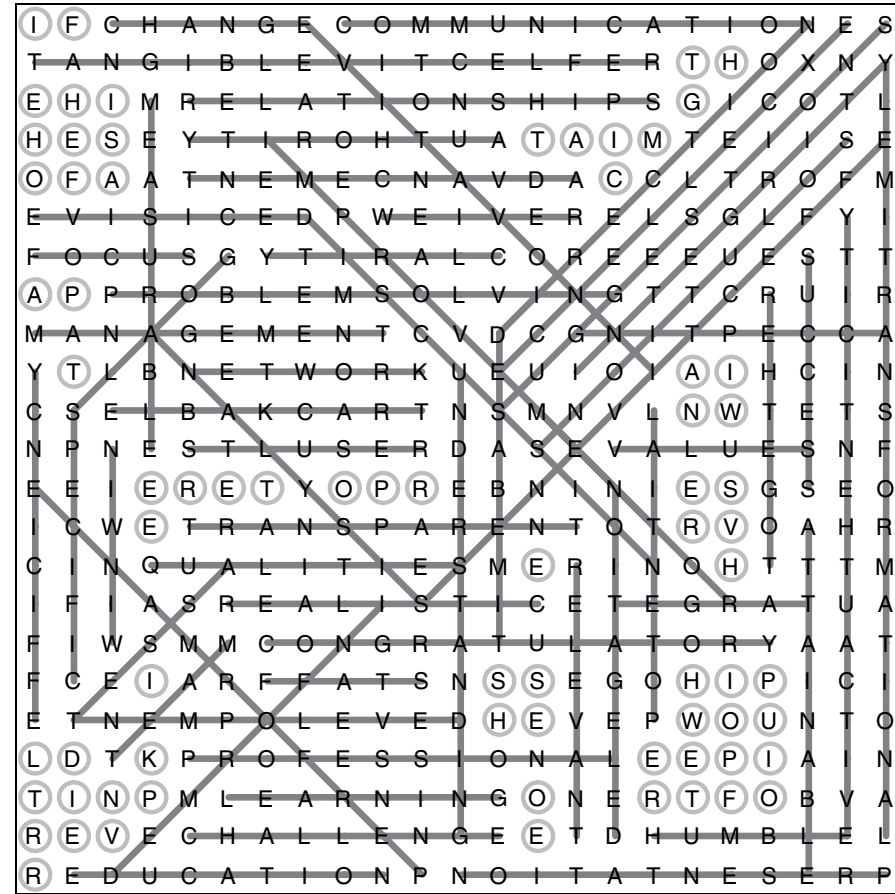


MONSTER FIND-A-WORD LEADERSHIP

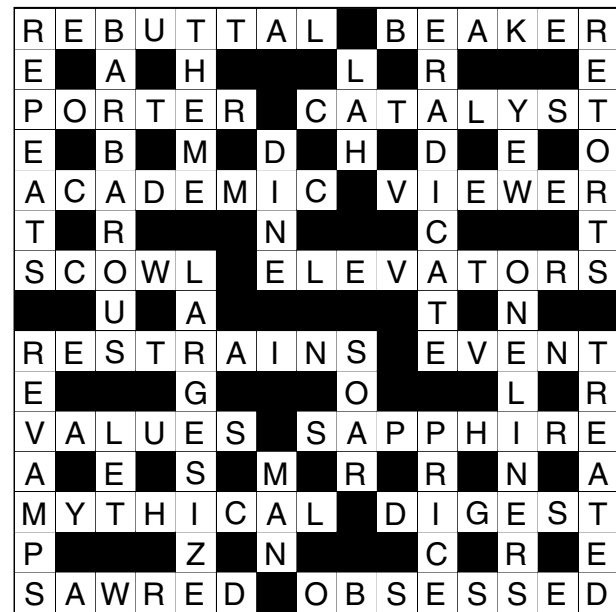

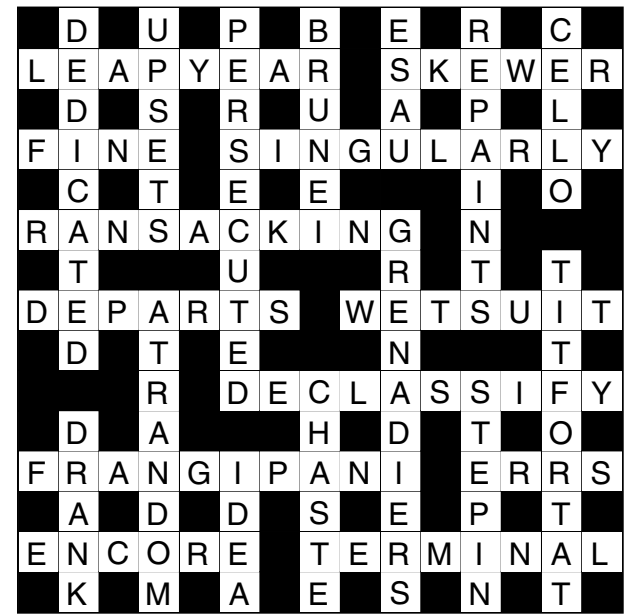

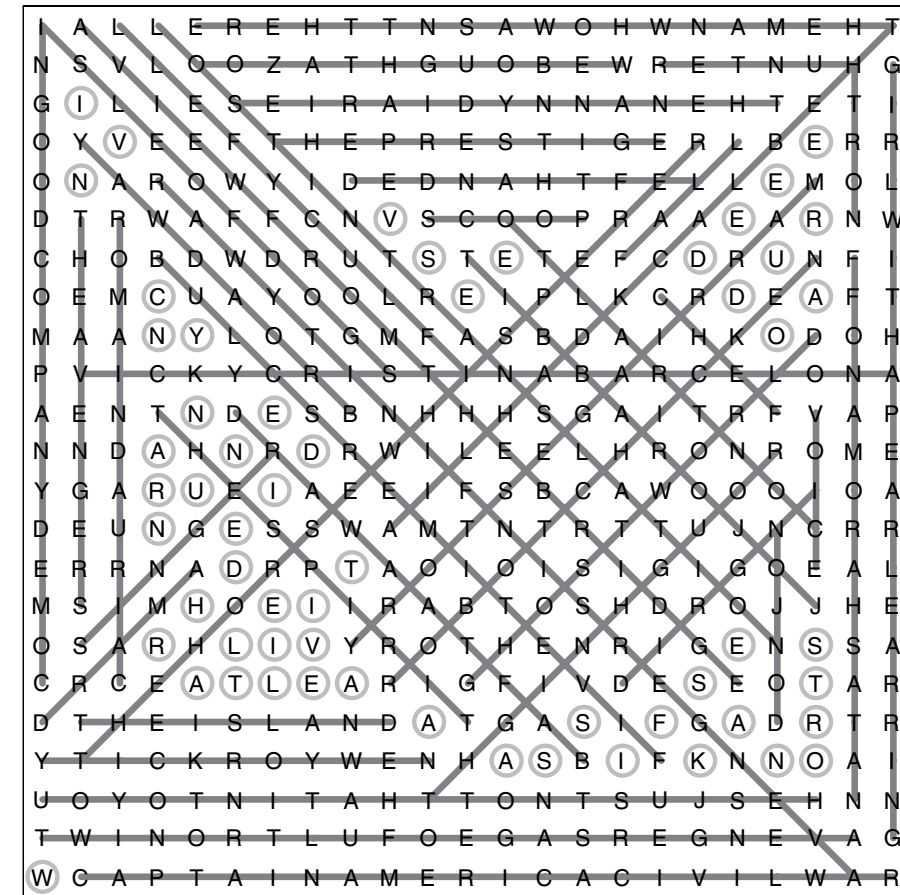
